

Oxford Farm Riding Lessons/Fees

We are currently contracted with Heather Uhall to provide riding lessons for **Beginner to Advanced Riders** using horses provided by **Oxford Farm** or horses owned by the student rider and brought to the farm for his/her lessons.

Typical lesson fees are as follows:

Private Lessons		Group Lessons (3-5 equally matched students)	
One hour	\$40	One hour	\$30 per student
Two hours	\$75	Two hours	\$60 per student
Three hours	\$100	Three hours	\$85 per student

Beginners and **Advanced Riders** usually benefit most from Private Lessons...Upon request, **Advanced Beginners** and **Intermediate Riders** will be matched with other compatible student riders for group lessons at the instructor's discretion.

Lessons will begin and end on time only if everyone is prompt and self-reliant with tack and grooming responsibilities. Students are expected to arrive 20-30 minutes early to prepare for the lesson. Ten to 15 minutes are usually needed after the riding part of the lesson to untack, cool down and return your horse to the pasture. Your time in the saddle will depend on how well you preform your pre-ride preparation and post-ride responsibilities.

Students paying for 5 lessons in advance typically receive one lesson free.

All riders must follow the instructor's directions and failure to do so may result in termination of the lesson without refund. All riders must wear appropriate clothing, footwear, and helmets.

Students arriving more than a few minutes late may forfeit their lesson without refund. (Instructors may use their discretion with private lessons but group lessons are particularly sensitive to late arrivals and this must be respected.)

Students who board a horse at **Oxford Farm** have the use of the arenas and trails when they are not being used for lessons or other scheduled events. Oxford Farm lesson horses may be available to non-boarding students for practice rides for a reduced fee and only upon the instructor's approval and recommendation.

All persons participating in equine activities must sign the liability waiver regardless of whether they ride or just plan to watch. Those under 18 must have a parent or guardian sign the waiver on their behalf. All non-riders and/or observers must remain in the designated observation area.

No dogs are allowed at **Oxford Farm** other than the ones that live here full time. Thank you for your cooperation.
